Beginning, Middle, End Game

Cut apart the cards at the bottom of the page and listen to the events in the story <u>Thank You, Omu</u>. Your teacher will read the events from the story (that are listed below) aloud. If you think the event took place at the beginning of the story, hold up the green card. If you think it comes from the middle of the story, hold up the yellow card and if you think it comes from the end of the story, hold up the red card. Every correct answer is worth one point. Try to earn as many points as you can!

Events:

- Omu shared so much stew that there was none left for herself.
- A little boy showed up at Omu's door because he smelled the stew, so she shares some with him.
- Omu feeds many people in her neighborhood, including a baker, a dancer, and even the mayor!
- The people in the neighborhood that ate her stew came back and brought food with them to share with Omu.
- Omu cooked a thick red stew and its delicious smell wafted out the window and throughout the streets of the city.
- A police officer smelled the stew and wanted some, so Omu shared stew with her as well.
