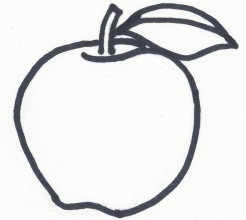


# I Can Use Context Clues

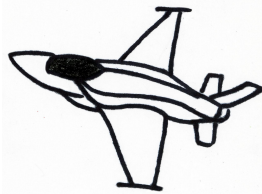

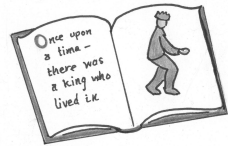
The adolescent wore her favorite skirt to school. The young girl liked the ruffles on it.



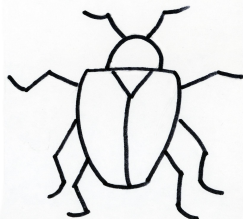
We enjoyed eating the fruit from the orchard. Our favorite kind were the hard, green ones.



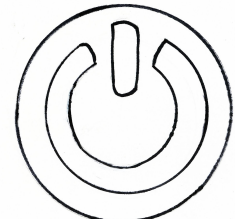
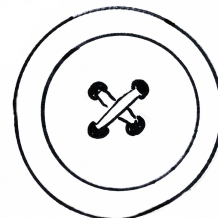
The plane was made to fly at supersonic speed. We could hear the loud boom from it.
