

# Plural Nouns



When talking about more than one noun, the plural form of the noun is used. For most nouns, simply add a letter **s** to the end to make it mean more than one. For words that end in **x**, **ch**, **sh**, or **s**, add **-es** to the end of the noun. If the noun ends with a letter **y**, change the **y** to **i** and add **-es**.

Examples:

**Add s:** dog- dogs

**Add -es:** box- boxes

**Change y to i and add -es:** fly- flies

**Directions:** Think about the words in the boxes. How should they be made plural? Write their plural forms in the box next to the word. The first word has been done for you. Now, cut out the boxes and sort them by how they changed to make them plural. Glue the sorted words under the correct flap onto a blank page of your writer's notebook.
